

The Long Island Museum Presents:
Juried Art Show 2009

Works on Paper

Calling all artists!
Here's a chance to have your work displayed in a museum!

Entry Information

Eligibility: Open to all artists, both amateur and professional. *All submissions must be works on paper.* Work must be original and not previously exhibited at the Long Island Museum in its juried shows. Long Island Museum employees and their immediate families/household members are not eligible to enter.

Awards: Cash prizes will be awarded for 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place and honorable mention.

Space: Finalist selections will be displayed in the Gillespie Room, in the Carriage Museum, from August 15 through September 7, 2009. Winning entries will be displayed in the entrance hall of the Art Museum from September 10 through October 25, 2009.

Limitations: There is no minimum size requirement. The maximum size is 40"x 40". All works must be ready to hang, and all hanging hardware must be provided. Three dimensional pieces cannot be larger than 40" in any one direction and pedestals (if needed) must be provided. Completed entry form must be on reverse of all pieces. Up to three entries per person may be submitted.

Submission Guidelines: All images of entries must be submitted by **July 10, 2009**.

E-mail submissions are preferred. Actual artwork will not be accepted at this time. Entrants may submit up to three works through one of the following methods.

By Email: Send one image for each work submitted to art@longislandmuseum.org in accordance with the **digital entry guidelines below**. You must then mail a completed entry form with a check or money order to the museum.

By mail: A CD must be clearly labeled with the artist's name and title of works.

Include no more than one image per work. CD entries must also adhere to the **digital entry guidelines below**. Mailed entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form and non-refundable entry fee. If you would like your CD returned you must include a self-addressed stamped envelope.

Digital Entry Guidelines

All digital entries must meet the following specifications: File names = artist's last name followed by the entry number as noted on the entry form (i.e. Jones1.jpg, Jones2.jpg, etc.). The image files should be in JPG format, image resolution should be 72dpi and no larger than 2000 pixels in any direction. Images must be oriented properly (i.e. top of image is top of artwork) and be readable on a Windows based PC computer.

Fees: \$25 for Long Island Museum members, \$30 for non-members, for up to three entries. Please make check or money order payable to *The Long Island Museum*. If you submit your entry via email, you must send a check or money order in the mail. **Your entry will not be valid until payment is received.**

Delivery Instructions for Selected Art

Artists whose work has been selected for the show will be notified by telephone or e-mail by July 24, 2009. Artwork may be shipped or hand-delivered to The Long Island Museum, 1200 Route 25A, Stony Brook NY 11790. **Hand-delivered entries may be dropped off only on August 11 and 12, 2009, between the hours of 12:00 noon and 7:00 PM** in the Gillespie Room of the Carriage Museum. **The Long Island Museum is not responsible for lost or damaged artwork.** Shipped entries must be received by **August 10, 2009**. Please package artwork in reusable containers and enclose:

- (1) Prepaid return shipping label via U.S. Mail, UPS, or FedEx.
- (2) Check or money order for entry fee.
- (3) Completed entry form.

IMPORTANT: Except for winning entries, all hand-delivered artwork must be picked up on the following dates and times at The Long Island Museum: Tuesday, September 8, 2009 between 12 noon and 7 p.m.; Wednesday, September 9, 2009 between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Arrangements for pickup of works by the winning artists will be made after

October 25, 2009. A storage fee of \$5 per piece per day will be charged for pieces not picked up on the appointed days and artwork will be stored at the Museum at the owner's risk. Any artwork not picked up after 30 days will become the property of The Long Island Museum.

Awards Reception

An Awards Reception will be held on Sunday, August 16, 2009, in the Gillespie Room of the Long Island Museum from 2 to 4 p.m. Cash prizes and ribbons

will be awarded to the winners. The public is invited to attend to view the winning pieces, as well as to meet the artists.
