None – Exclusive opportunity for LIMarts members.

**Entry Deadline:** 

Friday, October 3, 2025 by 5:00 p.m.

**Entries:** 

High resolution digital images only (JPEGs up to 3mb), formatted for PC.

May submit **two entries** of artwork created within the past three years (no older than 2020).

- One entry will be chosen for the exhibition.

- Announcements regarding which pieces are chosen will be made by no later than October 17, 2025.

Medium:

LIMarts encourages any media; two-dimensional or three-dimensional.

Digital and installation will be considered.

**Maximum Size:** 

36" in width, including frame and 64" in height, including frame.

Drop Off:

Wednesday, November 12, 2025 between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.: Artists are to *drop off* their work at the History Museum; artwork should be ready to hang with all necessary hardware; artwork should be labeled on the back with artists' name.

Pick up:

Friday, January 2, 2026 between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Sales:

The Long Island Museum will retain a 30% commission on all work sold.

**Liability Insurance:** 

The Long Island Museum cannot insure work or be responsible for loss or damage. Your signature upon delivery and again at pick-up releases The Long Island Museum from responsibility from losses. You may want to retain your own insurance.
